Art Affair

The Art Affair committee would like you to be thinking of how you can help our event this year at the new location of Mary Munford Elementary School soccer fields on October 16th and 17th. Exhibitors are signing up for the event, food and drink are being added to the festivities. We are looking forward to a great event.

There are 2 available spots in the group tent. The cost for each 10 x 10 foot space in the large tent is about \$80. Please call Barbara Nelson at 379-4967 if you are interested.

The BAAA Charity Gallery Tent currently has 9 signed up and we will have room for 16 total. This tent will be available for exhibiting members who are not participating in the show with their own space. A fee of \$10.00 per painting with a limit of 3 paintings per artist is to cover the tent and screen costs. When a painting is sold a 30% commission paid by the artist to our charity (ART 180) will be due. Change in Constitution

In order to continue the process of applying for our 501 C3 status, as previously voted on and agreed to, we need to slightly amend our Constitution and By-laws as follows:

Constitution, **Article One: Name and Purpose**

Section Two: Insert the words "educate, our membership and the community". Delete the words "painting, sculpture, and photography". The paragraph will now read : Our objective is to educate and nurture our membership and the community in all aspects of Fine Art expression and appreciation and for stimulating ideas and increase art knowledge.

Under By-laws, create **Article Six: Dissolution of Assets:**

In the event of the dissolution of Bon Air Artists Association the remaining assets will be donated to a non-profit educational charity as determined by the then current executive board.

This proposal is being advertised in writing and will be voted on at the September meeting. A quorum of 1/3 of the voting membership is required to revise the Constitution and By-laws,
