NOVEMBER, 2011 MINUTES

The meeting of November 4, 2011 was called to order at 9:30 am by President Nell Chesley. There were no visitors. The minutes were approved as published in the newsletter.

Jean Miller asked anyone not receiving a newsletter to notify her. Treasurer Gloria Callahan reported that our current balance was \$2954.34. There had been many extra expenses this past month including permits, fees, and board insurance. She announced that she would begin accepting dues payment today. Dues will be considered delinquent by January 15th and a late fee will be assessed after that date. Our application to become a 501c3 has been delivered and Gloria has been promised a response within 90 days.

Nell Chesley announced that we had two new members. Suzanne Jepson thanked Joyce Satterwhite, Gina Venn, Garry-Lou Upton, Pat Meek and herself who had all brought refreshments for the meeting. She asked for people to sign up for the future meetings and shared that Phillis Elliot was feeling better after her surgery.

Sally Lawson was not present but had provided a sign-up list for the Christmas Luncheon next month that will be at Crossroads at 11:30 on December 2nd. She also asked for volunteers to help set up at 10:00.

Dee Justin told us about today's program with Victoria Dye who teaches photo/computer classes locally. Victoria will introduce us to various visual formats.

Trish Berry said that the Tuckahoe show was up and hanging. Sylvia DeShazo and Dee Justin had chaired the show and also arranged for a show next year as well. SunTrust will be hung at 10:00 December 3rd. No prices on the front of the card that is placed on the front of the painting. The price should be on the back with a notation on the front card "see back for price". Cedarfield is rescheduled for January 6th. Chairman Pat Trgina has health problems and Garry-Lou Upton volunteered to chair the show in her stead and deliver the paintings after the Friday meeting if they were wrapped and brought to the meeting. Larry Robinson announced the change at Winchester. All dates and times will be in the newsletter

Kathy Miller announced that Mary Marshall has a new address and reminded all member to get any changes to her by January

Joanie Harper announced that Mary Marshall thanked everyone for calls and letters. Nell reported that \$50.00 will be donated to Crossroads in honor of Rhoda McCallum after polling the board for approval. Garry- Lou Upton announced that Pauli Hagan's father had died.

Old Business

President Nell Chesley recognized the Art Affair committee, volunteers, and artists. They all received an enthusiastic ovation. Marti Franks thanked all who had made donations which had been extraordinarily generous.

In September Vince Calabrese had suggested that we look into renting a space at Crossroads that would include us in their advertising. He now proposed that we rent the side car gallery, September 20–November 5, 2013, which is the first available date. The cost will be \$500 rent with Crossroads receiving a 15% commission. That would be 34 paintings at \$15.00 per painting. The opening reception will be September 20, 2013. Artists will bring food for the reception. Wine will be sold by UNOS at \$4.00 a glass. Advertising will be in **Style, Richmond Times Dispatch** and possibly **Richmond Magazine**. Postcards will be sent out by UNOS and Crossroads who will also feature the show on their websites. The artist whose work will be on the cover will be selected by lottery. Garry-Lou Upton will chair the show. Money will be due by August 15th prior to the hanging. The show will conflict with Art Affair, but it was felt that it would be a good synergy. 800-1200 people attended the last opening in September. Vince moved that we proceed with this idea. It was seconded by Larry Robinson and passed unanimously. Nell asked for a show of hands from those present get an estimate of how many would bring a painting. The count was 25. Trish Berry moved that we reserve a space for 2014 also. It was seconded by Vince Calabrese and passed unanimously. The discussion then moved to doing something similar in 2012. Uptown Gallery was suggested and a committee was formed of Vince Calabrese, Kathy Miller, and Patrice Reese; chaired by Kathy Miller to research the possibility. The motion to proceed was made by Gloria Callahan, seconded by Patrice Reese and unanimously approved. (*continued on Page 4*)

Richmond Art Workshop's Patrice Reese announced that Skip Lawrence will be teaching March 19th–23rd. There are still 3 spaces left. Send money to Mandy Peterson now if you are interested in attending. Donna Zagotta will be teaching May 14th–18th. Mary Whyte and Greg Packard will teach in 2013.

Garry-Lou Upton announced that Linda Baker will be returning next year to teach another workshop. Mary Jo Beswick will teach a three day workshop in January on exploring visual language and Nicholas Simons will be teaching in 2014.

Kathy Miller announced the Vera Dickerson workshop, November 16th–20th at Uptown Gallery. Christopher Wynn will also be teaching there in December. Sign up forms are on the table. Kathy also announced that Bev Perdue Jennings and Patrice Reese were featured artists at Uptown tonight. Patrice is featuring a series on chairs and Bev is featuring paintings from Italy.

Suzanne Jepson and Gloria Callahan have an exhibition at Cooper's vineyard in Louisa this weekend. Ellie Cox is running a trip to Provence in January. Garry-Lou Upton has an opening at Crossroads next Tuesday. Betsy Kellum, Sue Stuller, and Garry-Lou Upton have all updated their studios at Crossroads. Ronda Dandliker is showing soft pastels at the Visual Arts Center.

President Nell Chesley called a joint Board meeting between the BAAA board and the Art Affair board, January 4th at the Bon Air Library at 9:30 am. Norie Burnet thanked everyone for cards and calls after her hip transplant and reported that Dan Decker from The Foundation for Chester Art Center had requested a representative from our group to be on the board. Marti Franks volunteered and was approved.

Judy Pollard requested that Art Affair not conflict with the Folk Festival next year. Gloria Callahan explained that our show had been on the third weekend of October for 19 years. The Folk Festival was a moveable date and in fact they had changed their date after all arrangements had been made.

The meeting was adjourned at 10,25 am.
